Hot! Hot! Summer Days - As most of you know, we can have days that the temperature can reach over 100 degrees by noon. Our outdoor time is done mostly in the morning hours and no later than 11:30 AM. Academic Day – The teachers continue to teach during the summer. The idea is to review what was covered during the Fall and Spring. Statistically it is estimated that a student can forget up 20 to 30 percent of what they learned during the school year in the summer. We keep their brains active to prevent the loss of knowledge.

Rules and Policies - The only two people that can alter school policy or rules are Mr. and Mrs. Medina. Teachers, teacher aides or office assistants do not have the power to make changes. For example, if your child is not returning in July, notification of this must be done in writing. No verbal agreements can be accepted between staff and parents. As per our school contract, this notification needs to be done in writing 10 days prior to the end of the month. Those students who want to return in the fall and did not comply were either placed on a wait list or dropped.

Uniforms- Students may wear the grey Apple Bee t-shirts for the summer or the regular school uniform. The t-shirt can be worn with any bottom. Do not send the boys with the Apple Bee school shirt combined with anything other than khaki pants or shorts.

AG program- Pre kinder, Kinder and 1st grade students continue to work with the Life Science program. The students have summer crops to work with. The students are growing sweet corn, watermelons, cantaloupes, honeydew melons, squash, tomatoes, sweet peppers, and sunflowers. As the crops grow, the students will take some home. Once again, we ask that if you do not want any of these crops that you let the teachers know.

Fourth of July Holiday – The Center **will be closed** Thursday July 4 in observance of Independence Day.

Fourth of July Parade - The parade will be held on Wednesday July 3rd. The parade will start at 8:30 AM. The children will have a Fourth of July picnic at the end of the parade. The picnic is **only** for the children. The children are encouraged to wear patriotic colors and outfits for the day. We will have the following contests: Most decorated Spirit Stick, tricycle and/ or wagon.

Summer Supply Fee - The fee is \$ 48 dollars to cover June and July.

Covered parking area - This area is designated for staff only. Please do not park there. Thank you.

Lights off - The hallway and classroom will sometimes have only half of the lights on during the day due to high daytime temperatures.

Tuition – The fee is due on the 1st of the month, however, we give you until the 5th day of the month to pay with out a \$ 20.00 late fee.
